Sree Narayana Mandira Samiti (SNMS) is an educational and charitable Trust established at Mumbai in 1963 by a group of devotees of Sree Narayana Guru (1855-1928), who was a visionary saint, philosopher and social reformer, considered as the architect of Kerala Renaissance which brought about revolutionary changes in the social fabric of the country.

Embarked on educational and social service programs in the M ward of Mumbai (Chembur west), which is one of the poorest and most backward areas, SNMS has been able to make a difference in the living standards of poor people in the area by providing quality education to thousands of children in these families and enabling them to get employment or to start their own business ventures. Over the years SNMS expanded its humanitarian services through its various regional centers spread across Mumbai and other parts of Maharashtra thereby making a social stamp.

SNMS is a multicultural organization which firmly follows the principles and ideals of Sree Narayana Guru in the service of humanity. It operates through the central office at Chembur and 41 regional centers (Units) spread over Mumbai and surrounding districts of Maharashtra. SNMS has about 15000 life members and 1000 patrons who largely contribute to its activities through voluntary services and financial contributions. As a registered educational and charitable trust, SNMS is exempted from Income Tax under section 80 G of the IT Act.

SNMS services are available to all the general public on a non-discriminatory basis.

Administration

SNMS is governed by its own Bye Law having the following features:

- Elected Administrative Body (***General Council***) consisting of Office Bearers, Unit Secretaries (*currently 41 Units*) and Council Members (*six per unit*). General Council decides on Policy matters.
- **Board of Management** consisting of Office bearers, Unit Secretaries and Patrons
- Office bearers are President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, General Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, and Zonal Secretaries (*currently 8 Zones*)
- Election is held once in three years and life members and patrons are eligible to vote.
- Day to day administration is handled by the Committee of ***Office Bearers*** under the direction of the *Board of Management*.
- Office Bearers are assisted by various sub-committees on specific subject matters (*e.g., Advisory Board, Planning Board, Cultural Wing, Women's Wing, Youth Wing (YAVA), Balavedi, Education committee, Finance committee, Event Management Committee, Gurudevagiri Committee, etc.*)
- Unit administration is the responsibility of Unit Secretary in consultation with Council members, supported by Unit level sub-committees on specific subject matters.
- SNMS is divided into territorial zones comprising 5-6 units (*territorial jurisdiction looking after membership and regional service activities of SNMS*). Each zone is headed by a zonal secretary who is also an Office Bearer.
- Financial and administrative matters of the Units are controlled and monitored by the committee of Office Bearers.
